The Briton 4700 Series of door hardware is a high quality, high specification range of lever and pull handle door furniture and accessories in satin stainless steel.

The range encompasses the complete hardware requirement of the large majority of doorsets.

Features & Functions

- Back to back fixing bolts and threaded bushes provide a strong bolt through fixing
- Also supplied with face fixing screws
- Slimline escutcheons only 4mm thick to match rose mounted levers
- Unique 'ClickFit' system provides a positive snap fit for pressed rose and escutcheon covers
- Bathroom turn and indicators supplied as a set with bolt through fixings and spindle for doors 38 - 44mm thick as standard (other sizes available to order - see table overleaf)
- Bathroom function spindle 8mm
- Available in a high quality satin stainless steel finish

General Maintenance

Door Furniture

Door furniture, including lever handles require very little general maintenance.

Annually check for smooth operation and ensure the lever freely returns to the horizontal position. Ensure all fixings remain tight.

Annually check pull handles, bolts, door stops, signs and indicators paying particular attention to all fixings.

General cleaning procedures should be followed in accordance with the "Care of Finishes" on page 16 of the 'Service & Maintenance Guide'.



ACCESSORIES

Provided it has been installed correctly and is used in conjunction with a suitable lockcase, your door furniture accessories should require only occasional checking and cleaning. Highly finished items which are regularly handled should be checked more frequently and kept clean.

The operation of the lever handles and/or bathroom thumbturns should be checked in association with checking the lockcase (see lockcase data sheets).

MONTHLY

Check the furniture for dirt and grease and wipe clean as directed by the "Care of Finishes" on page 16 of the 'Service & Maintenance Guide'.



ANNUALLY

Check that all fixings are tight (this may mean removing the snap on covers of escutcheons) and that the thumbturns and indicators are properly aligned each side of the door.



Check the operation of thumbturns and indicator/emergency releases on bathroom locks ensuring they operate the deadbolt smoothly.
